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Student Commencement in 2025

Dear families,

To support students returning to school in 2025, we are holding student conferences. The purpose of the conference is to ensure a smooth transition to the new year level, to discuss behaviours or concerns that the Ballam Park staff may need to know and to clarify positive strategies that work with your child.

These conferences will include the student, the parent/carer, teacher and education support staff member. There will be a set of guiding questions that will be sent home via email. You are welcome to answer these prior to the interview or to bring them in on the day. The questions will include:

- · What are your child's strengths at school including academic and social/emotional behaviours
- What are your child's areas of focus
- What strategies do you feel support your child
- Any other specific information

The staff at Ballam Park regularly communicate using evidence and data to create profiles of our student, but the addition of the student and family's input is invaluable.

The interviews will be held on Wednesday 29th January, commencing at 11.30am. The interview will run for 15 minutes per student. Please use the link on COMPASS (to be provided) to book your interview. Please note, the education support staff will only be in interviews until 2.00pm.
